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i. **Church Registration:**

This excel sheet (2010.Church.Registration.xls) can be downloaded from the web-site, [standandshout@gmail.com](mailto:standandshout@gmail.com) E-mail back to us NO LATER than Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>.

ii. **Medical Release Form:**

Provide an original form, per camper, completely filled out, signed and notarized. Attach copy of health insurance card for every member in your group. You will turn them in at registration.

iii. **Deposit:**

To ensure a spot for each of your campers send a \$50 non-refundable deposit per person, see below for due dates. The final balance is due when you arrive at MOG/WOG.

Include your contact information, when you mail-in your deposit.

**\$120 for Early bird:**

**\$50 non refundable deposit due by Nov. 11<sup>th</sup>**

This locks you in at \$120 per person.

**\$140 for late registration:**

**\$50 non refundable deposit due by Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>**

This locks you in at \$140 per person.

\* After December 9<sup>th</sup>: You are financially responsible for all spots reserved.  
If you have additions after December 9<sup>th</sup>, please call for availability.  
If space is available, you may add campers.

iv. **Final Balance:**

The final balance will be noted on your confirmation letter. **Bring your final balance to the retreat, we will receive it then.**



## V. What Your Students Need to Bring

### **What to Pack:**

- Bible and pen.
- Extra spending money, there is a snack shop (they have great ice-cream).
- Bed linens (twin bed)/sleeping bag and a pillow.
- Towels.
- Toiletries.
- Covered toed shoes and clothes for rec.

### **What NOT to Pack:**

- Any type of Electronic Device - this includes CD/MP3/iPods and two-way radios.
- Any type of Drug or Alcohol (the student will be dismissed at his/her expense).
- Any type of Knife or Weapon (this includes pocket knives).
- NO FIREWORKS OF ANY KIND!!
- Shaving cream & cell phones are to be used at the appropriate times.

### **What to Wear:**

- Casual clothes for 3 days: Modest shorts, jeans and shirts, and cloths for rec. time.

### **What NOT to Wear:**

- Cloths that are too tight or too short or too low cut. Guys, no “busting-a-sag”
- No T-shirts with distasteful designs or messages.
- No Spaghetti-strap tops.

\*Remember, we are trying to keep the students focused, we don't want any distractions.

Make sure You have enough chaperones (1:7 ratio is a recommended min.)

Have a parent meeting (THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT)

- o Have parents fill out student's medical release forms
- o Inform students and parents of the "do's and don'ts"
- o Have chaperones fill out medical release form
- o Communicate Departure and Arrival times
